The UC Davis Pediatric Outpatient Telemedicine Program offers health care providers and patients real-time remote consultation and evaluation through interactive, high-definition video and audio communication. The program enables children living in distant communities to receive care from UC Davis Children's Hospital pediatric subspecialists without traveling to Sacramento.

Clinical telehealth consultations with a UC Davis pediatric specialist are available for:

Outpatient consultations are scheduled weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Appointment length varies by specialty.
